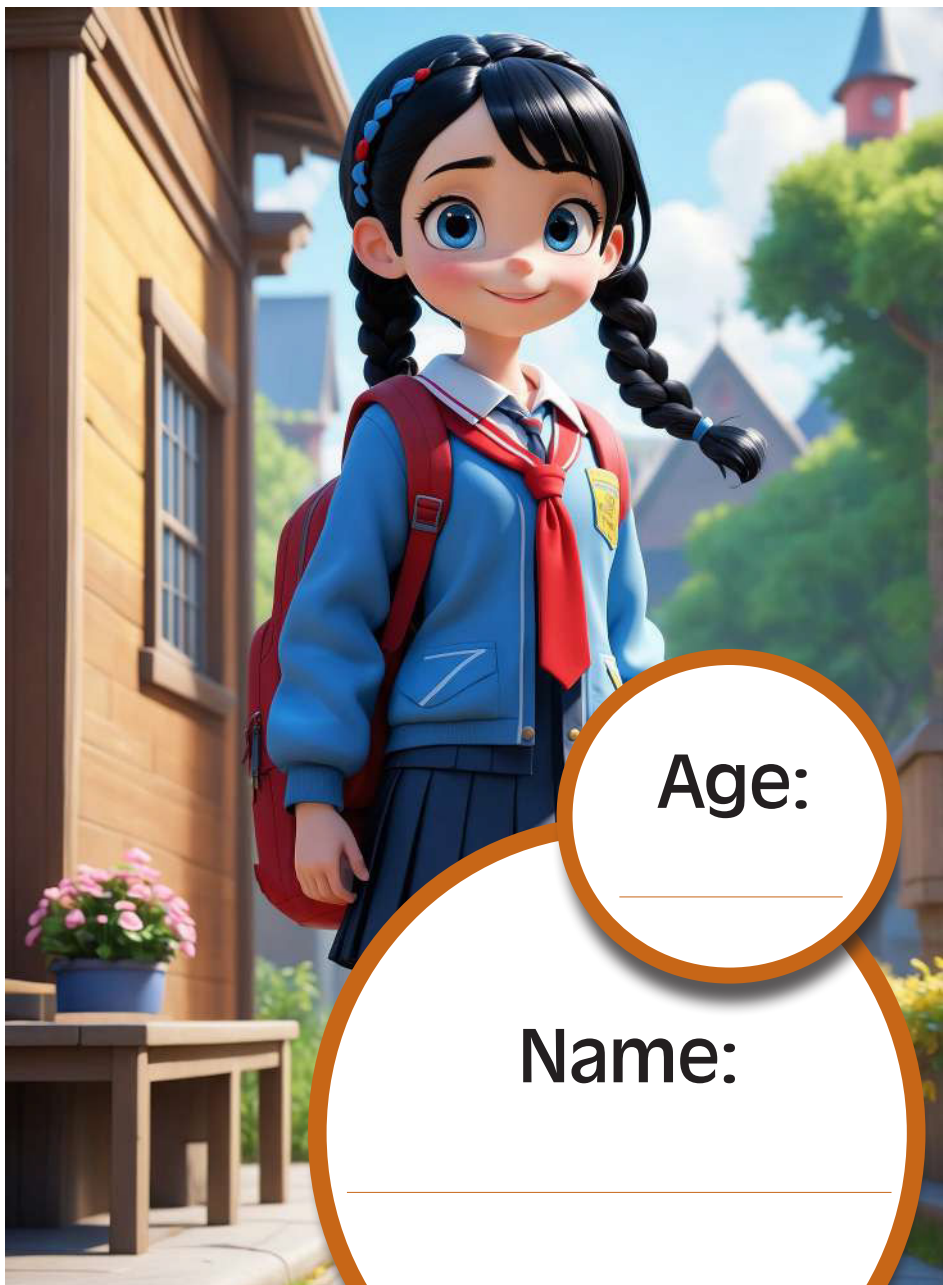

Isaiah 41:21

“Present your case,” says the LORD. “Bring forth your strong reasons,” says the King of Jacob.

One day, a Roman centurion had a servant who was very sick. The centurion believed Jesus could heal him, so he sent some Jewish elders to speak to Jesus on his behalf. At first, Jesus didn't go with them. But when the elders explained how kind the centurion was—and how he had helped build their synagogue—Jesus went with them immediately (Luke 7:4–6).

The elders presented strong reasons, and this teaches us something powerful about prayer.

When you talk with God, He wants you to present your case using His Word. That means you don't just pray, *“Lord, please help me.”* Instead, you pray with reasons from the Bible—God's promises!

For example, you can say: *“Father, your Word says all things work together for good to them that love you (Romans 8:28). I love you, so I declare that everything is working for my good!”*

That's how to pray boldly and confidently—with strong reasons from God's Word.

A ransom is the full payment made to rescue someone and set them completely free. And that's exactly what Jesus did for you! He paid the full price so you could be free from sin, guilt, fear, and everything that could separate you from God.

After Peter and John healed the lame man, the leaders warned them never to speak or teach in the Name of Jesus again. But instead of being afraid, they gathered with the other disciples and prayed. They asked God for boldness to keep preaching the Gospel.

As they prayed, the whole place shook! But that shaking wasn't God's answer. God's real answer was the Holy Spirit. The Bible says they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and then they spoke God's Word with boldness (Acts 4:31). Hallelujah!

Therefore let it be known to you... that through this Man is preached to you... and by Him everyone who believes is justified from all things from which you could not be justified by the law of Moses.

As God's child, God has already declared, "You're forgiven and free from sin!"

This is called justification. It means God sees you as clean, right, and perfect in His eyes. Jesus took your place so you could take His place—standing before God as His special, beloved child.

The Supremacy Of The Bible— 2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:20-21.

The Bible is God's Word, and it will never get old or change. It's always true, has no mistakes, and is complete.

The Bible contains the Word of God, which I've described as follows:

1. The Word is God's message to us. It shows us what God does, what He wants, what He thinks, and His good plans. It helps us know God and be close to Him in love.
2. It's God's true message that has power to help us grow and become more like Jesus. It teaches us who Jesus is, what He has done for us, and how to live.
3. It helps us know what is right, shows us when we're wrong, corrects us, and teaches us how to live the right way.

Living In Two Worlds— John 8:23; John 18:36; Romans 12:2; John 15:19; Colossians 3:1-2; Hebrews 12:22.

As a Christian, you've been moved into God's Kingdom. You're not waiting to get there. The moment you believed in Jesus, you were placed in God's Kingdom. You're there right now—not only when you go to Heaven.

Heaven is part of God's Kingdom and is a real place. But while you're here on earth, you live in the part of God's Kingdom that is at work on the earth. Jesus is the King of this Kingdom, and it's called the Kingdom of Heaven.

In this Kingdom, just like any other kingdom, there's a King and there're rules to live by. Learning these rules helps you live well and enjoy all the good things God has given you in His Kingdom.

Colossians 1:13 *"He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love"* But you may ask, "Why do I still live in my house?" That's because God's Kingdom is a spiritual Kingdom, and God is a Spirit. This doesn't make it less real—it makes it even greater! The spiritual world came first, and the physical world came from it.

So now, you live in two worlds: the spiritual world and the physical world. As a child of God and a member of His Kingdom, you have God's power to live above problems and not be controlled by the limitations of the physical world.
