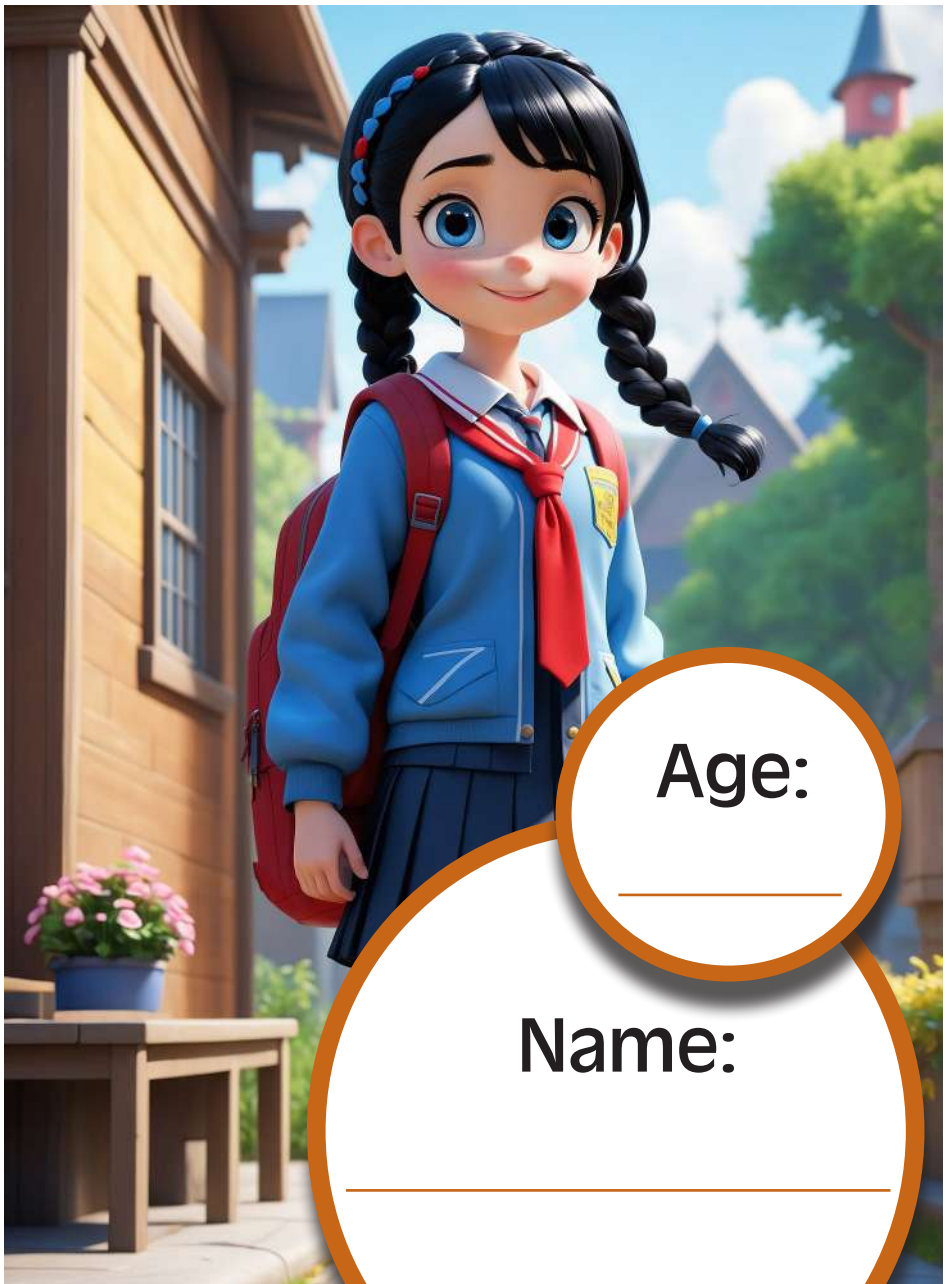

THE POWER OF WORDS

1. **God created everything on Earth by speaking.** This shows that words carry power (*Genesis 1*). God's Word brings creation and life.
2. **Our words reflect what is in our heart. What we say flows from within us** (*Luke 6:45*). Words reveal character and faith.
3. **Our words can bring life or cause harm.** What we say can bless people, make them happy, or hurt them deeply (*Proverbs 18:21*). Words carry consequences.
4. **Kind and loving words bring joy to others.** They can make people feel loved, encouraged, and strong again (*Proverbs 16:24*). Words can heal and uplift.
5. **Wise people control their words.** When we learn to talk carefully, we protect ourselves from trouble (*Proverbs 13:3*). Wisdom is shown in restraint.

6. **We must speak words that build others up.** Our words should help others grow and feel confident (John 6:63). Words should strengthen, not tear down.
7. **Our words should inspire others.** God wants us to speak words that encourage people, not words that make them sad (Ephesians 4:29). Encouragement is God's design for speech.
8. **God listens to the words of His children.** When we speak in faith, God hears us and is pleased (Malachi 3:16). Faith filled words reach God.
9. **Jesus spoke to the wind and the storm, and they obeyed Him.** This shows that faith filled words can change situations (Mark 4:39). Jesus demonstrated authority through words.
10. **Jesus' words give life.** The words of Jesus are full of power. When we listen to Him, we become strong inside (John 6:63). His words remain the ultimate source of life.

2 Corinthians 4:18

While we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal.

God wants you to also see with the eyes of your spirit, not just with your physical eyes. Seeing by the Spirit means seeing the way God sees. It is choosing to believe what God's Word says rather than what your eyes see around you.

That's exactly what Prophet Elisha did in the Bible. When the Syrian army surrounded the city where he was staying, he was calm because he saw in the spirit that those who were with him were more than the army. And with that, he won against them (2 Kings 6:16-18).

God's Word helps you see beyond fear or any challenge. It shows you who you are in Christ: strong, loved, and victorious.

**More Important Christian Doctrines – Romans 5:17;
Romans 5:21; Hebrews 6:1-2; Hebrews 9:12-14;
Romans 1:17; 2 Corinthians 5:7; 1 Corinthians 6:11; 1
Thessalonians 4:4, 2 Timothy 2:22**

In Hebrews 6:1-2, the Bible shows us some important teachings.

I. Repentance from Dead Works – Hebrews 9:12-14

- Being saved isn't about the good things you try to do. We're made right with God by faith in Jesus.
- Hebrews 9:11-14 tells us that Jesus' blood cleans our hearts so we can serve the living God.
- Long ago, people gave animal sacrifices. But Jesus already finished the work of salvation.

You cannot give many cows or do many good deeds to earn salvation. You only need to believe in what Jesus has done.

II. Faith Towards God – Hebrews 11:1-6; Romans 1:17; 2 Corinthians 5:7

Titbits

- The Bible says in Hebrews 11:1-2, *“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. For by it the elders obtained a good testimony”*.
- The Christian life is a life of faith. We walk by faith, not by sight (2 Corinthians 5:7).
- Before we were born again, we followed only what we could see and feel. Now, we trust God’s Word.
- God has given every believer faith (Romans 12:3). We grow our faith by hearing and obeying God’s Word.

III. Baptisms

The word “baptise” means to dip or put fully into.

a. Baptism of the Holy Spirit (New Birth) – 1 Corinthians 12:13; Ephesians 4:4-5

- This happens when a person is born again.
- You become part of God’s family.

b. Water Baptism – Romans 6:3-5; 1 Peter 3:21

- This is when a person is dipped into water.
- It shows that we believe in Jesus’ death and resurrection.
- Jesus told us to do this as a sign of our faith.

IV. Laying on of Hands

Laying on of hands means placing hands on someone to bless them or pray for them.

In Numbers 27:18-23, Moses laid hands on Joshua.

Later, Deuteronomy 34:9 says Joshua was full of wisdom.

Other examples:

- For healing (Mark 16:18)
- To minister the Holy Spirit (Acts 19:6)
- To stir up spiritual gifts (1 Timothy 4:14)
- To appoint leaders (Acts 13:1-3)
